The services offered by the Plympton Veterans Centre include:

- Assistance and advice in the preparation of Primary Claims and applications for increased benefits under the VEA and MRCA/DRCA;
- Advice on applications for the review of decisions made under the VEA;
- Preparation and presentation of cases for review to the Repatriation Commission;
- Preparation and presentation of cases for reconsideration under MRCA/DRCA;
- Preparation and presentation of cases appealing Section 31 decisions for hearing to the Veterans' Review Board (VRB);
- Welfare continues to be a large part of services delivered by PVC. Services have included Suicide Assist, Homelessness, Food Vouchers, Family Support, Widows, Aged Care Placement, Bereavement, Income Support and assisting those involved in the Defence Abuse Reparation Scheme.
