Tailem Bend Regional Advocacy Outreach Visit 20 September



On 20 September 2019, veterans who have undertaken military service in the Australian Defence Force and are living in Tailem Bend and nearby communities are being offered a free advisory and advocacy service by the Plympton Veterans Centre. The Centre which is based in Adelaide; organises country visits as part of its regional advocacy program.

Our specialist Veterans' Advocacy Service can give advice about rights and entitlements for pensions, disability claims, war widow claims and other benefits under the various veterans' acts.

Our service can also help veterans in their dealings with the Department of Veterans Affairs and can lodge appeals and represent veterans before the Veterans' Review Board.

We also offer practical help, including help completing forms and questionnaires and help lodging pension claims.

This service is open to veterans who served at home, in peacekeeping forces or in armed conflict at any time.

We will be bringing 2 accredited Advocates to Tailem Bend on 20 September 2019 to offer this service.
